## WACKY TOY WEDNESDAY





**Term 4 starts on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> October, and Learning from Home will continue until Friday 9<sup>th</sup> October.**


**At this stage all students will return to on-site learning on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> October in the second week of term 4.**






