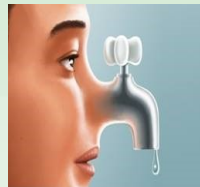


WELCOME BACK

COVID-19 REQUIREMENTS

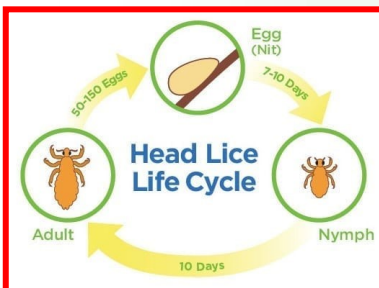
- ◆ Water bottles to school

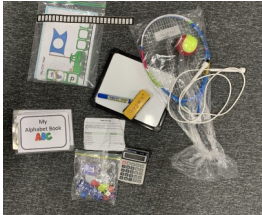


SCHOOL REPORTS
